WHEREAS, the Legislature enacted F.S. 683.19 (1991), permitting the chief judge to designate Good Friday, Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur as legal holidays; and

WHEREAS, it would be an appropriate sign of respect and religious tolerance to close the courts in Monroe County on Good Friday, Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur so that litigants, court personnel and attorneys may observe these important holy days;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that all courts in Monroe County shall remain closed on Good Friday, Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur and these days will be holidays for persons employed by the courts.
