IN ACCORDANCE with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Rule 2.050(b) Fla.R.Jud.Admin., it is

ORDERED that:

Unless otherwise specially ordered in a particular case, all business of the circuit and county courts shall cease upon the posting of hurricane warnings by the US Weather Bureau for the Monroe County area, and shall resume only when the emergency is over.

All matters scheduled for hearing during the period affected by this rule shall be deemed canceled, and the same shall be reset upon application by any party, or sua sponte by the Court.
