COURT REPORTING SERVICES PLAN

WHEREAS, a recent analysis of the circuit's court reporting services plan revealed that some clarification may be necessary;

In consultation with the circuit court and county court judges of the 16^{th} Judicial Circuit,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Administrative Order No. 2.039/98-1, In re: Court Reporting Services Plan (Amended), is hereby amended:

Section 4 in its entirety is replaced as follows:

4. Civil hearings and trials shall be reported by private court reporters as arranged by the parties. However, because it is uncertain at the time of jury qualifications whether the trials to be heard will be criminal or civil, all jury qualifications will be reported by employee court reporters or recorded electronically when such equipment is available.

This order shall take effect December 1, 1999.
