WHEREAS, the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida's Drug Court Program incorporates case management as one of its essential services; and

WHEREAS, the federal poverty guidelines have been changed since this original administrative order was issued;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Administrative Order 4.007, *In re: Drug Court Costs Assessment* shall be amended as follows:

The ordering paragraph shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** that all adult defendants who receive case management services in conjunction with the Circuit's Drug Court Program be assessed by the court reasonable costs to defray the expense of case management services based upon each individual's ability to pay, and pursuant to the amended recommended schedule attached.

Recommended Fee Schedule

| <u>Household Adjusted Gross Monthly Income *</u> | <u>Monthly Fee</u> |
|--|--------------------|
| Below \$735 (FPL)** | \$ 25 |
| 735-1500 | \$ 35 |
| 1500-2500 | \$ 50 |
| 2500-3500 | \$ 85 |
| 3500-4500 | \$ 100 |
| \$4500 and up | \$ 150 |

*Client's household adjusted gross monthly income: deduct \$250/month for each eligible dependant for the adjusted gross monthly income.

**FPL: the Federal Poverty Level income figure is \$735/month or \$8820/year.
